The meeting started at 4:00 pm with a welcome by Denise Bergman. The committee was reminded that the purpose of the meeting was for each school to go over the two goals they set for FY20 in the area of Student Wellness.

- 1. Festival Foothills, Patrick Miller went over many of the goals in our Wellness Plan that he believes Festival has already implemented and some areas they plan to expand on in the coming year. Some areas they intend to grow are in Nutrition Education information going out to families and to have teachers be proactive being active amongst students.
- 2. Hassayampa, Cory Monesmith indicated that they will be making sure the teachers are having "brain breaks" during class time and will be hanging posters next to drinking fountains.
- 3.
