The Dan Doom Student Athlete Scholarship is available to any Wickenburg High School graduate who desires to continue his/her education at a college, university, vocational or trade school. Applicants must have been active participants on any sports team during their time at Wickenburg High School.

During his 50+ year tenure as a teacher and coach of multiple sports at WHS, Coach Doom took special interest in helping student athletes achieve their highest potential. The scholarship is intended to continue that legacy and build upon it for the next generation.

The Dan Doom Student Athlete Award scholarship is available to two types of applicants:

Primary Scholarship: Two to three \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded to current year WHS graduating seniors who meet the eligibility criteria.

Legacy Scholarship: One to two \$1,000 scholarships may be awarded to previous award recipients who are in year two or more of their post-secondary education.
